As part of our commitment to international recognition and quality assurance, ACE is expanding its pool of assessors and invites qualified academics and professionals based overseas to express their interest in serving as Overseas Assessors.

Overseas Assessors work alongside ACE's national assessors to review Self-Evaluation Reports (SER), conduct on-site assessment visits (in person or remotely), and contribute to the accreditation panel's deliberations for study programmes in education and related fields, both in Indonesia and overseas.

About ACE (LAMDIK)

ACE (LAMDIK) is a professional, independent accreditation body dedicated to assuring and enhancing the quality of study programmes in the area of education. ACE accredits study programmes through a rigorous, standards-based process encompassing eligibility review, self-evaluation, adequacy assessment, on-site assessment, and a final accreditation decision made by an independent accreditation panel.

Role and Responsibilities of an Overseas Assessor

- Review and evaluate Self-Evaluation Reports (SER) and supporting documents submitted by study programmes.
- Participate in adequacy assessment to determine whether a study programme meets the criteria for on-site visitation.
- Serve as part of an on-site assessment team, verifying data, evidence, and conditions through engagement with university leaders, faculty, and study programme staff.
- Prepare written assessment reports, including findings, recommendations for improvement, and proposed scores against ACE's accreditation standards.
- Participate in accreditation panel meetings to discuss assessment findings and contribute to accreditation decisions.
- Uphold the independence, objectivity, and confidentiality expected of an ACE assessor throughout the accreditation process.

Qualifications

Applicants should meet the following qualifications:

- A doctoral degree (Ph.D. or equivalent) in Education or a related field.
- Demonstrated experience in higher education accreditation and/or quality assurance.

- Senior academic or professional standing, reflecting significant experience and recognition in the field of education.
- Fluent proficiency in English, both written and spoken.

Interested candidates are invited to submit an expression of interest by email to the ACE (LAMDIK) Secretariat, sekretariat@lamdik.or.id, with the subject line “Expression of Interest – International Assessor.” Applications should include:

- A current curriculum vitae (CV);
- A cover letter outlining relevant experience in higher education accreditation and/or quality assurance; and
- Contact details of at least two professional referees.

Applications should be submitted no later than 30 September 2026. Shortlisted candidates will be contacted for further discussion and onboarding.
